Louisiana Trooper Foundation Honors William Dore'

The Louisiana Trooper Foundation recently held its Board of Directors meeting on Wednesday, February 7, 2007, during which William J. Dore' was recognized for his outstanding efforts and service to the Foundation since its inception.

Dore' was honored by the Board with the title of Chairman Emeritus of the Louisiana Trooper Foundation. In June of 2001, William J. Dore' became the Foundations's first Chairman of the Board of Directors and continued to serve in his position until November 2003. Though he has retired from his post as Chairman, Dore' continues to stay active in support of the Foundation's mission.

The Louisiana Trooper Foundation is a nonprofit organization founded in 1999. It's mission is to work in partnership with the community and business leaders in supporting the Louisiana State Police with their continuing efforts to better serve the citizens of Louisiana. One of the goals of the organization is to develop, establish and support youth mentoring programs which promote positive interaction between Louisiana State Troopers, youth and communities. The Foundation's most successful program, Camp-Win-A-Friend, partners Louisiana State Troopers with youth from around the community. The summer camping program is designed to teach integrity, values, respect and self-confidence. Troopers volunteer their time to become mentors and camp counselors during the program.

Dore', a Louisiana native from New Iberia, is a successful entrepreneur and philanthropist. His Sulphur, LA based company, Global Industries, Ltd. is a worldwide organization of over 3,000 employees. Global Industries operates one of the largest fleets of marine construction assets in the world. Mr. Dore's many contributions and accomplishments in the oil and gas industry has earned him recognition both nationally and internationally. Dore' has been the recipient of numerous awards for his life accomplishments, most notably the 2000 Horatio Alger Award. This prestigious national award recognizes our country's most successful and admirable men and women who have overcome significant personal adversity through hard work, integrity, determination, and a strong dedication to helping others.

It is this dedication to helping others that led Dore' to becoming involved with the Louisiana Trooper Foundation. Among his many contributions, Dore' established a fund to assist Louisiana State Troopers who lost their homes and whose families were displaced due to Hurricane Katrina.
